Anti-Defection Law Needs Change: MGP

Panaji: The Maharashtra-wadi Gomantak Party (MGP) on Tuesday approached the high court of Bombay at Goa seeking an order to restrain former Congress MLAs Dayanand Sopte and Subhash Shirodkar from contesting the by-elections.

After resigning as MLAs, the duo joined the BJP, necessitating the by-election in their Mandrem and Shiroda constituencies. The MGP is a coalition partner in the BJP-led state government.

Alleging that the speaker had not secured the personal presence of the legislators while accepting the resigna-

tion, the petitioner said, the resignation was sent by fax by the MLAs when they were in Delhi.

"It is not disclosed/examined by the speaker the place from where the resignation was faxed by the members," the petition said, adding, "The petitioners ha-

ve an apprehension that the resignation was sent by the speaker by the MLAs as the national president of the BJP."

The petitioner said the speaker should have considered the circumstances which persuaded the two MLAs to tender their resignations.

The petitioners submit-

ted that considering the circumstances and the background, the speaker was duty-bound to consider that the resignations were against the mandate of the electorate and provisions of the Constitution. "The resignation can be accepted after the meeting of the members con-

cerned with the BJP national president. The speaker did not think it fit to make any inquiry into the genuineness and willingness of the members concerned. The speaker did not receive any notice from the Congress. The resignations are contrary to the rules, in force as well as the interest of the electorate," the MGP petition read.

The MGP said material on record is not sufficient to show that Sopte and Shirodkar's resignation was voluntary or genuine. It said that they had joined the coalition party; the members have been rewarded with chairmanship of two different state corporations—the Economic Development Corporation and Goa Tourism Development Corporation.

The party has sought to quash the decision of speaker Pramod Sawant accepting the resignations of the

two former Congress MLAs.

The petition has also sought a direction to the Election Commission of India to send appropriate recommendation to the government and the law commission seeking amendment to the anti-defection law to disqualify members of either Parliament or legislative assemblies or councils, who resign from the membership without any justifiable reason, from contesting fresh elections and/or occupying any public posts for a period of six years.

The petition said health minister Vishwajit Rane was also lured to resign as Congress MLA. After resigning, he contested fresh elections on a BJP ticket and got himself elected. The facts would demonstrate that he resigned from his party membership previously to become a minister; the petitioner said.

'Will add Sudin's name to petition if he joins BJP'

In the writ petition filed before the high court, MGP has said there is not enough material on record to show that the resignations of Sopte and Shirodkar were voluntary, as they were lured by BJP by promising them prominent positions.

MGP working president Narayan Sawant also said it was neither against the government nor was it a pressure tactic to send appropriate recommendation to the government and the law commission seeking amendment to the anti-defection law to disqualify members of either Parliament or legislative assemblies or councils, who resign from the membership without any justifiable reason, from contesting fresh elections and/or occupying any public posts for a period of six years.

But vice-president Ratnakar Madhakar was quick to add that if Sudin Dhavalikar joined BJP to become the chief minister, they would move the court against him, too. "We will add Sudin's name to the petition," Political observers said there was a proposal from BJP that Sudin merge MGP with BJP and become chief minister. Sawant was evasive as to when the party would approach the court when health minister Vishwajit Rane quit Congress and joined BJP in March 2017. "We are waiting for other political parties to file the petition," he said.

While MGP leaders have tried to downplay the political implications of the petition, analysts said there must be several considerations related to the current churning.

One reason may be that through the petition, MGP wants to send a signal to MLAs that if they join the BJP, they will be dragged to court.

The other, according to a party watcher, may be that

MGP wants to shake BJP up from its comfort zone of an ailing chief minister running the government.

Observers reckon that by filing the petition, MGP has brought to the fore the simmering differences with BJP over various issues.

For long, Dhavalikar's name has figured in political circles as the senior-most minister to get the mantle or at least temporary charge to run the state administration.

With the ground situation remaining unchanged despite BJP president Anand Shah tweeting in September-end about reallocation of portfolios, there is growing resentment among the coalition partners and sources said, many in private support MGP on the issues that it has raised.

With the national election season heating up, BJP will be making all out efforts to retain both Lok Sabha seats—North and South Goa—a but as the last few elections have shown, MGP plays a significant role for its victory or at least for the high victory margin, especially in South Goa. One of the reasons that Narendra Sawkari could wrest the seat from Congress in 2014 was due to the huge lead he gained in assembly segments represented by MGP.

This time, if MGP doesn't go into its senior partner for the parliamentary polls, BJP may find roadblocks especially in South Goa. Knowing this well, MGP may be increasing its bargaining power to take pole position.

Another reason, according to an analyst, is that with MGP now playing dominant role, it may push the government into a constitutional crisis leading to dissolution of the House.

Observers say that the political situation may be far from clear. Development may be in the offing after December 11 when results of the assembly polls to MP, Chhattisgarh and Rajasthan will be known.

Plea in interest of public: PWD mantri

Panaji: PWD minister and senior Maharashtra-wadi Gomantak Party (MGP) leader Ramkrishna Dhavalikar on Tuesday said that the decision to file a petition in the high court was not against the government, but in the interest of the public.

Dhavalikar told TOI that, since 2000, MGP has been campaigning to change the anti-defection law in a bid to prevent elected representatives from jumping parties.

The MGP is the most affected party in the state owing to the present anti-defection law, he said.

The MGP is a major coalition partner of the BJP-led government in the state, on Tuesday approached the high court of Bombay at Goa to restrain former Congress MLAs Dayanand Sopte and Subhash Shirodkar from contesting the by-elections.

"It is not against the government, but in the interest of the public," the PWD minister said, responding to a question whether the petition was a pressure tactic.

"The MGP asked the court to quash the decision of speaker Pramod Sawant accepting the Sopte's and Shirodkar's resignation as MLAs.

At present, the anti-defection law allows legislators to resign and contest elections, but we want the law to be changed to deter MLAs from repeatedly resigning and jumping to other parties, he said.

"This decision will strengthen the governments MLAs will not leave parties," Dhavalikar added.

Will sort out differences with MGP, says Vinay

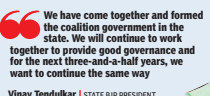

Citizens march to Parrikar's house, call for his resignation

Panaji: A group of citizens mostly comprising students and workers marched towards CM Manohar Parrikar's private residence at Dona Paula on Tuesday demanding his resignation for governance in Goa.

The group, shouting slogans, were stopped by police around half a kilometre away from his residence where they were taken to a police station. North Goa, Shashank Tripathi met them. Former CM Digambar Kamat, leader of opposition Chandrakant Kavalakar, Reginaldo Lourenco, Jennifer Monserre and Girish Chodankar also participated in the protest.

Social activist, Airo Rodrigues, presented a 48-hour ultimatum for Parrikar's resignation for governance in the state to be restored. Tripathi said he accepted it on behalf of the district administration and assured that it would be represented to the chief minister. The protest took place during the opening ceremony of the International Film Festival of India that is taking place at Shyama Mukherjee Stadium more than a kilometre away.

Senior cardiologist Francisco Colaco said "We will resort to all peaceful means to end this state of affairs."

Senior vice-president, NCP, Avinash Bhonsale said it appears that the CM is under siege. BJP state unit president Vinay Tendulkar condemned the march.

"We believe the governor has enough powers to dissolve this government if there is no administration taking place."

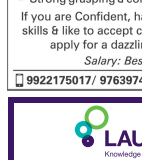
